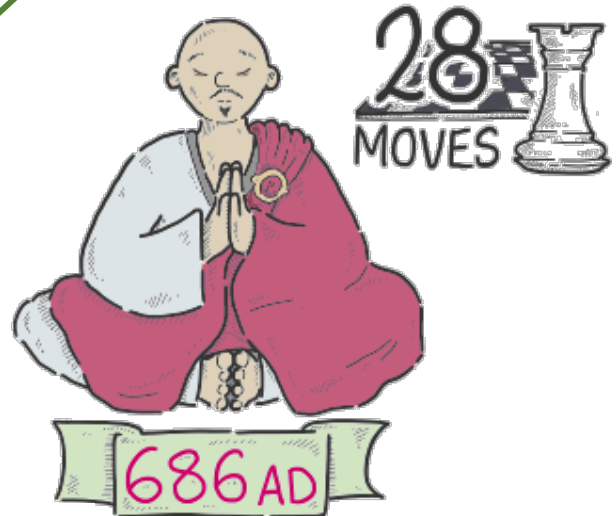


WON-HYO

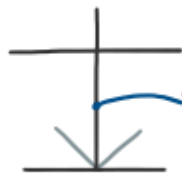
Won-Hyo is the monk who introduced Buddhism to the Silla Dynasty in 686 AD.



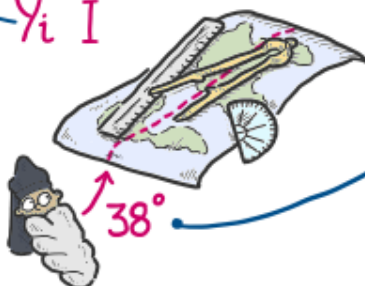

Yul-Gok is another name for Yi I (1536-1584 AD) who was a philosopher and scholar nicknamed the "Confucius of Korea".

The 38 movements refer to Yi I's birthplace; on the 38th degree latitude. The pattern diagram represents the Korean symbol for the word 'scholar'.

An Joong-Gun assassinated Hiro Bumi Ito, the first Japanese Governor-General. Hiro Bumi Ito was part of the Japanese plan to take over Korea, so was assassinated in 1909 as part of the Korean-independence movement.

The 32 movements refer to An Joon-Gun's age (32 years old) when he was executed in Lui-Shung prison in 1910.
